

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## Election of Parish Councillors for Harbledown and Rough Common (Harbledown)

1. An election is to be held for four Parish Councillors for Harbledown and Rough Common (Harbledown).

**2. Nomination Papers**

Nomination papers may be obtained from the Clerk to the Parish Council who is Mr David Frost, 7 Limes Place, Upper Harbledown Canterbury, CT2 9DW.

Nomination papers may also be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer, Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW on Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (excluding bank holidays) who will, at the request of the elector for any electoral area, prepare a nomination for signature.

**3. Delivery of Nomination Papers**

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4 pm on Wednesday, 3rd April 2019.

**4. Poll**

If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 2nd May 2019.

**5. Absent Voters**

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Friday 12 April 2019. Applications can be made online:

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW by 5 pm on Monday, 15th April 2019.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW by 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW by 5 pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.
